Physicians' Conscience Rights at Risk

In August of 2008, President Bush's administration officially released new regulations protecting pro-life doctors and medical personnel from involvement in abortions and related practices.

These protections include penalties for facilities receiving federal funds that discriminate against pro-life doctors on abortion, and also protect medical facilities that don't want abortions performed on their premises.

In still yet another concession to pro-abortion forces, Barack Obama is threatening to overturn these protections very soon. He has instructed the Department of Health and Human Services to rescind the clause protecting conscience rights of pro-life health care workers.

However, the Obama administration is first permitting an open comment period, and citizens may email their opinion to propose-drecession@hhs.gov or via freedom2care.org; deadline April 9, 2009.

Funding Abortion Overseas

Through Barack Obama's Executive Order overturning the Mexico City Policy, enacted January 23rd, we U.S. taxpayers will now fund abortions overseas, at an increase from \$88 million to \$545 million.

In recent budget pork piling, Obama also overturned the Kemp-Kasten Amendment restrictions against funding the United Nations Population Fund, which includes among its programs support for China and its one-child policy, forced sterilizations and forced abortions. The UNFPA will now receive \$50 million.

Radical Freedom of Choice Act Coming Soon

Every assault Barack Obama has promised against innocent human life is occurring. Despite media and others' attempts to brush off the seriousness of this so-called Freedom of Choice Act (Unrestricted Abortion Act), it will be considered very soon in the U.S. House and Senate, with little changes from past years' attempts to introduce this extremist legislation. FOCA overturns all pro-life state and federal protections for women and unborn children of the past three decades, and establishes a national "right" to abortion at any time during a pregnancy for any reason.

Ohio Resolution Opposing FOCA

State Senators Tim Grendell and Steve Buehrer have introduced a resolution in the Ohio Senate, and a large group of representatives in the House, opposing the federal "Freedom of Choice Act" (FOCA):

The Freedom of Choice Act is a radical attempt to enshrine abortion-on-demand into American law, to sweep aside existing laws that the majority of Americans support, such as requirements involving fully informed consent, parental involvement, and that licensed physicians perform abortions, and seeks to prevent states from enacting similar protective laws in the future.

The Senate resolution is co-sponsored by Senators Coughlin, Gibbs, Schaffer, Seitz, Wagoner, Schuring, and Faber; and in the House by Representatives Adams, Huffman, Watchmann, Amstutz, Hottinger, Mecklenborg, Boose, Balderson, Derickson, Martin, Lehner, Jordan, Gardner, Bubb, Uecker, Morgan, Mandel, Wagner, Grossman, Stautberg, Zehringer, and Blair.

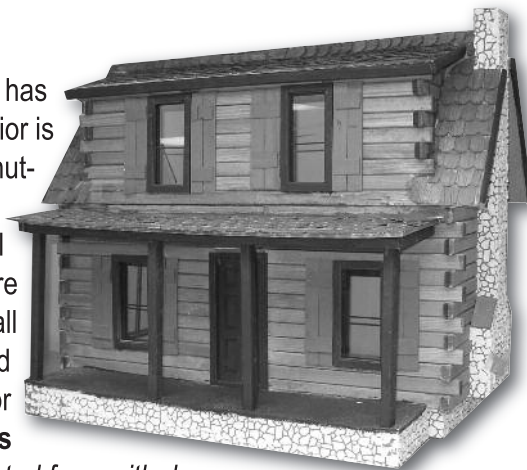

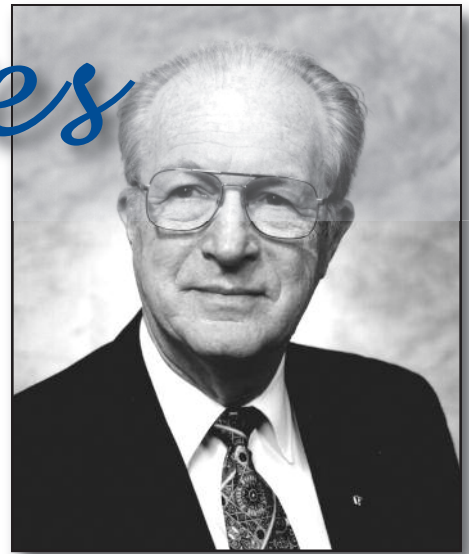

Dr. Willke Writes

BARACK OBAMA'S DESTRUCTIVE PATH

Below is a list, as of this printing, of what Barack Obama has done to ensure federal assaults on protections for innocent human life.



- ♦ Overturned President Bush's restrictions to allow federal funding of unlimited killing of human embryos for embryonic stem cells; and overturned Bush's policy to fund ethical, non-lethal research on adult (non-embryonic) stem cells. There are no laws or restraints on embryonic stem cell research, but private funding (due to persistent failure) is rare.
- ♦ While saying he is opposed to human cloning, left the door open to create clones and then kill them for their parts.
- ♦ Proposed rescinding a federal policy protecting the conscience rights of health care workers. This will force those workers, including doctors, as well as institutions to perform and provide controversial services, such as abortion that conflict with their personal, moral and religious beliefs.
- ♦ Created a new executive policy position at the United Nations to advance radical feminist policies, and named Hillary Clinton's former chief of staff, Melanne Verveer, to head it.
- ♦ Convened a Health Care Summit at the White House (no pro-life groups invited) including Planned Parenthood, to push for universal health care, which will include mandatory abortion coverage and require all health insurance companies to include abortion.
- ♦ Reinstated federal funding of the United Nations Fund for Population Activities. This will provide \$50 million for the genocidal Chinese abortion program, which had been stopped during the Reagan and Bush administrations.
- ♦ Nominated aggressive pro-abortion, Kansas Governor Kathleen Sebelius, to head the Federal Department of Health and Human Services.
- ♦ Nominated radical pro-abortion activist, David Ogden, for Deputy U.S. Attorney General. For years, Ogden has defended hard-core pornography, and opposed child-porn protections in federal law and in public libraries.
- ♦ Opposed health care coverage for pre-born babies in federal health insurance (S-CHIP).
- ♦ As state senator, voted against the *Born Alive Infant Protection Act*, which ensures basic medical care to babies born alive after a failed abortion.
- ♦ Will support Senate ratification of the radical feminist *CEDAW Treaty* at the U.N. intended to make "reproductive health" the leading edge of new global health initiatives.
- ♦ Directed sharply increased funding within the U.S. for "reproductive health services."
- ♦ Appointed Dawn Johnsen, a former NARAL attorney as Assistant Attorney General for the Office of Legal Counsel. Johnsen has publicly stated that she views pregnancy as slavery and involuntary servitude.
- ♦ Chose strong abortion agenda advocate, Elena Kagan to be Solicitor General of the U.S. Kagan will represent the U.S. before the Supreme Court.
- ♦ Created a new office, the National Coordinator of Health Information Technology to "monitor treatments to make sure your doctor is doing what the federal government deems appropriate and cost effective." If implemented this will give the Feds power to determine who gets life saving treatment and who doesn't.
